### You're making my family stronger and healthier

My name is April, and coming to Community Care Athens, an East Texas Food Bank partner was one of the best decisions I've ever made. It was also one of the toughest. You see, I was raised to be independent. I believe in taking only what you need and leaving the rest for people who are worse off.

I work full time teaching preschool. My husband does flooring, which is seasonal work. It's difficult to raise our children on such a limited income. Most of the time we make do, but between paychecks it helps to have resources like this.

Very simply, you put food in our stomachs when we need it. I have a few tricks I use to stretch every last bit of food. Some nights I'll make vegetable soup with mixed veggies, tomato sauce and stewed tomatoes from the food pantry. That way I'm being responsible and making every last meal stretch. I like to pick up bread, rice, beans and pasta for my family, too.

#### Between paychecks, your kindness sustains us

Coming to the food pantry frees up funds we wouldn't otherwise have. I can pay the bills and buy staples like milk, eggs, butter and cheese. Thanks to you, I can pick up food that might be too expensive to purchase at the grocery store.

When families like mine are struggling, you raise us up. It's a wonderful thing, and I'm so very grateful. You've shown us that people out there genuinely care and want to help.

# Danielle sees your life-changing impact firsthand

Danielle Atteberry remembers the moment Hilda and Regan walked into her life. She'd just begun her workday as the development director at St. Paul Children's Foundation, one of the East Texas Food Bank's partner agencies in Tyler.

The elderly couple walked right up to Danielle and explained that they'd never asked for help before, but they really needed it now. Living on a fixed income made it impossible to afford food, clothing and critical medications. They'd been going without food and couldn't stand the hunger pains.
