

**The following guidelines apply to Persons
60 Years of Age or Older who participate in the
CSFP Senior Box Program**

Eligibility is based on **total GROSS Household income and size (i.e., number of household members) of a participant's household**. Participants qualify for USDA Foods to supplement the individual's dietary needs **if their total GROSS household income is equal to or less than the figures provided** in the table below.
