Program Spotlight

New resource center offers comprehensive services under one roof

We are thrilled to announce that our newest outreach, the Deep East Texas Resource Center (DETRC), officially opened on May 7. With the support of friends like you, the DETRC will offer services that otherwise wouldn't be available in the Lufkin area. These include:

- A food pantry where guests can choose the groceries they need
- Nutrition classes in our demonstration kitchen
- Help applying for benefits assistance programs, like SNAP and WIC
- Assistance with utility payments
- Help applying to community colleges
- Health screenings
- Financial counseling
- Child care
- Referrals to Goodwill and other social services

In addition, a large warehouse and walk-in fridge will enable us to keep nearby pantries well stocked.

This new facility is designed to be a "one-stop shop" for low-income families in Deep East Texas, where access to healthy food and other



resources has historically been very limited. However, thanks to generous friends like you, everyone who comes to the DFTRC is welcome—our services aren't limited to residents of Lufkin.

Now here's the most exciting part: We've already seen such success in the four months the resource center has been open that we're planning to build two more just like it!

Innovative expansion like this simply wouldn't be possible without donors like you. Even more remarkable is that you helped make it happen during the pandemic. What a testament to the power of your compassion!
