Benefits Assistance Program

We're here to help in many ways

Many people don't realize the number of ways that the East Texas Food Bank can assist them in times of need. One of those ways is the Benefits Assistance Program. This program helps eligible East Texans complete the application process required by the state to receive food assistance and other wrap-around services, which are often needed in times of economic hardship or emergencies.

These services include:

- SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)
- Medicaid
- TANF (Temporary Aid for Needy Families)
- CHIP (Children's Health Insurance Program)
- Healthy Texas Women and Medicare Savings Program

The Benefits Assistance Program also provides referrals to other agencies, such as WIC (Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children) and housing, shelter and utility assistance programs.

Deep East Texas Resource Center celebrates anniversary

The Deep East Texas Resource Center (DETRC) in Lufkin celebrated their one-year anniversary this spring with an open house for chamber members.

DETRC is a one-stop-shop of wraparound services including a food pantry, benefits assistance and other support services for families in deep East Texas. Nutrition education classes are also conducted so clients can learn how to make healthy meals for their families.

Tresa learned about DETRC from a friend. "I had never been to a pantry before where I could pick out the

foods I wanted. The selections are great."

"This past year we served 6,370 households from our DETRC location," said Dennis Cullinane, CEO of the East Texas Food Bank. "We are delighted with the number of families we were able to assist in our first year. As we continue to see rising food costs we only expect to see a greater need in the year to come."

Patricia relied on places that served meals to get something to eat before DETRC opened. "Now I have a place I can come to go shopping for the



food I want to make and it's close to where I live."

Funding for the DETRC was made possible with a grant from the T.L.L. Temple Foundation. The T.L.L Temple Foundation works alongside rural communities to build a thriving East Texas and to alleviate poverty, creating access and opportunity for all.
