MORE STATS AND DIFFERENTIAL IMPACT:



RETURN-ON-INVESTMENT: Over 96% of all support goes directly to programs and services.



REACH: ETFB distributes food throughout a 26-county service area that spans nearly 20,000 square miles.



IMPACT: ETFB serves more than 175,000 families a year, providing approximately 34 million meals.



SCALE: ETFB joins forces as an affiliate member of the Feeding America and Feeding Texas networks.
